

SCORP (Standing Committee On Human Rights and Peace)

The concept of human rights is a very broad topic. In our actions, we focus on promoting such values as empathy, respect for other people or selfless help to those in need. We draw the attention of society (not only academic) to the issues of refugees and protection of peace, to situations and places where human rights are not respected.

We read We help

We read We help is an action during which we visit children in hospitals and try to make their time there more pleasant. During the classes, we read fairy tales, color, paint, paste, make plasticine and much more.

Dreamy Post

Dreamy Mail is an action for people who like to draw and want to devote their time to sending some joy to chronically ill children. During the meetings, we make cards with the favorite motifs of small patients with our own hands, to send them later by mail. Dreamy Post is also a great opportunity to meet new people and talk about interesting topics, there is always a relaxed and open atmosphere here. This is a great way to get away from learning and have a good time. Or maybe you personally know a child in a difficult situation who would be happy with colored cards? Here we are able to implement such a project.

Senior's Time

The project is addressed to the elderly. We rely on education, activation and integration of seniors through pro-health presentations, spending time together and cooperation with students of medical universities. During the classes, we will explain seniors the most popular diseases they face, we will spend time on conversations and art works. As part of the Senior's Time, for special occasions such as Christmas or Easter, we organize themed events.

Avenue of Stars

It is an action during which we visit kindergartens and primary schools, bringing children closer to the figures of the Stars. Who can become a star? A doctor, a nurse, a paramedic, and many others. The lessons are attended by people who talk about a given profession and the Star herself, which children can see up close and ask her questions. The project aims to broaden the horizons of children, familiarizing them with the image of people whose help they may one day need.

Let's Touch Diversity

Let's Touch Diversity is an action that has many views. It can take the form of presentations of people from other countries and be addressed to children and young people. It can be intended for students and aimed at learning to move in a wheelchair on the streets of Lublin. The goal is to show how diverse people live around us and get to know the unknown.

Letter Writing Marathon

Amnesty International project, in which we are involved in November and December, mainly around December 10, mostly during SCORP Week. The Letter Writing Marathon began in Poland in 2011 and since then many countries have been fighting together to ensure that people, unjustly convicted, regain their freedom. The idea is very simple: at the university, in cafes, in schools, we write letters and encourage as many people as possible to do so. In these letters, we demand human rights be respected in countries where they are violated, then the letters are sent to the authorities of countries where human rights are not respected. The action brings visible results, prisoners obtain better conditions for serving their sentence or go free.

Medics for Africa

A year-round campaign aimed at bringing closer the problems of health care in low-income countries, the epidemiology of tropical diseases or volunteering health care workers in Africa, but also on other continents.

DAPHNE

DAPHNE is a project where women are at the centre. Its main goal is to stop violence against women, raise their self-esteem, show solutions in difficult life situations. On the other hand, we educate students about how to identify victims of violence, how to have a conversation with them and how to help. The action can be conducted in many ways - lectures, workshops, e.g. self-defense, meetings and classes gathering women from different backgrounds.

Youth Among Rights

During this project, we educate students of primary schools about children's rights. The action can take place in a school, hospital, common room, community center, etc. After a short presentation of the material, we move on to discussions, tasks, competitions to interest the youngest as much as possible in such an important topic of their rights.

Teddy Bear Under the Hospital Christmas Tree

A large action, which helps to collect funds for Children's Clinical Hospital in Lublin. The main events of the action are the auction of Christmas baubles decorated by university's tutors, a charity football tournament which students' organizations from our university take part in and also kermesses. At the events, we also collect teddy bears for CCH charges. At the beginning of December, the action crowns the "procession of fairy-tale characters" in CCH.

Let's talk about Violence

A new year-round campaign to educate primary schools' students about violence. During the classes, we teach the youngest what violence is, what are its types, how to recognize it and provide them with knowledge on how and to whom to report a situation in which they themselves have experienced or witnessed violence.

Reuse it or lose it! #zerowasteproject

Project where the possibilities of various events are enormous. Creative actions and events related to the ideology of the zero waste movement are an ideal place for the development of people interested in the topic of caring for our planet, thanks to the reduction of consumerism. As part of the campaign, thematic webinars and workshops promoting the idea of less waste life are held.

Invisible

Homeless and poor people are often socially stigmatized, so it is important for future health care workers to treat them without prejudice, to bear in mind the equality and right to medical care for all people, and to do not agree on discrimination. The project deals primarily with emergency aid, organizing collections of clothes, hygiene products, food and medicines, as well as promoting pro-health behaviors and directing to places where help can be obtained, such as canteens or shelters for the homeless.
